Dr Mary Holohan qualified from medical school in Cork. She trained in obstetrics and gynaecology, achieving specialist certification in both Ireland and U.K. Appointed consultant in 1995, she was the first female obstetrician on the Rotunda Hospital Staff.

Dr. Holohan has a special interest in the impact of epilepsy on pregnancy, the management of post-dates pregnancy, the aetiology and management of female urinary incontinence and domestic violence issues in obstetrics and gynaecology. She has been director of the Sexual Assault Treatment Unit since 1998 and has been proactive in the development of a national forensic medical examination service for victims of sexual crime.

Her interest in teaching and the evaluation of training and continuing professional development has led to Dr. Holohan representing the Institute of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists on the Advisory Committee on Competence Assurance of the Medical Council.
