Dr Sam Coulter-Smith qualified in 1987 from the Royal College of Surgeons, Dublin. He began his training in Obstetrics at the Rotunda Hospital before moving to the UK. He worked in many of the major teaching hospitals in London including The Hammersmith, King's College and the Royal Free Hospitals. He returned to Ireland in 1996 as Assistant Master and Chief Assistant in the National Maternity Hospital, Holles Street and The Rotunda.

In 2002 he was appointed as a Consultant to The Rotunda. Since his appointment he has developed special clinics for infection in pregnancy and expanded the diabetic clinic. He initiated the Familial Ovarian Cancer clinic and works closely with the clinical genetics service in Our Lady's Hospital, Crumlin and the Breast and Colon Screening Units in the Mater Hospital. He took over as Master of the Rotunda Hospital in 2009. He has a keen interest in teaching and is involved in the postgraduate training programme at the Rotunda Hospital. He is committed to the ongoing development of services for women in pregnancy.
